

# Sample Ballot Decoded

The Ballot Question does not include a definition of "Gender Identity".

"Gender Identity Disorder" is classified as a mental disorder by the American Psychiatric Association. Legal protection against discrimination based on mental illness is not provided for any other disorder, and there is no rational explanation why it should be offered for this one.

Discrimination must not be tolerated, but women and children need to be protected from indecency and predators in rest rooms and showers. It has always been appropriate to discriminate by gender in public accommodations.

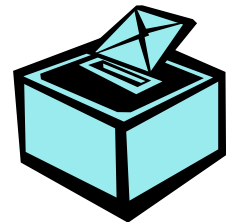
## Question C

### Referendum on Law Enacted by County Council Gender Identity Discrimination

Shall the Act to prohibit discrimination in housing, employment, public accommodations, cable television service, and taxicab service on the basis of gender identity become law?

This bill discriminates against the 500,000 women and children in Montgomery County by asking them to sacrifice their privacy rights. Women and children should be able to expect that **ONLY** people sharing their bathrooms and locker rooms also share the same biological sex. Other gender identity bills which have been passed across the US have recognized this issue and addressed it. Our county council did not.
