The County Council passed a "Gender Identity" Bill promoted by Equality Maryland. The County Council says the Bill has "never been about the bathrooms". But who's right?

Who's Right? The only other gender identity law in the state is in Baltimore City. It provides specific exemptions for restroom facilities, schools, employers, and religion. The Montgomery County bill is so broadly written as to include heterosexual cross dressers and female impersonators. There are no exemptions for the bathrooms, lockers and showers.
