

Language that was removed from Bill 23-07, as indicated by the revised Bill posted Sunday, November 11th:

Section 27-11 Discriminatory practices

[111] [[(c) A person must not deny any person access to the equal use of any restroom, shower, dressing room, locker room, or similar facility associated with the gender identity that the person publicly or exclusively expresses or asserts.]]

Section 27-19 Discriminatory employment practices

(An employer may not....)

[258] [[(c) deny any person access to the equal use of any restroom, shower, dressing room, locker room, or similar facility associated with the gender identity that the person publicly or exclusively expresses or asserts.]]

Reconcile this finally published language with the [CNN interview](#) on Friday morning where Council Member Duchy Trachtenberg [WOULD NOT answer the CNN reporters](#) question on whether the new bill's amendment would allow transgender males into women's bathrooms. Under this language, clearly and explicitly, transsexual males were allowed, and yet she refused to answer the reporter's question. Should you trust the Council now when it says that "people can figure out how to use the bathroom?"
